



Community Recycling Centers

Frequently Asked Questions

Q. *When are your recycling centers open?*

A. We have two locations; each is open one Saturday each month.

Q. *Where are the locations?*

A. Our Buckhead center, open the first Saturday of each month, is located at 2715 Peachtree Road, in the lower parking lot of the Second-Ponce de Leon Baptist Church. On the second Saturday of each month, our Kirkwood/Edgewood center is held at Coan Middle School at 1550 Hosea L Williams Dr. NE. Visit our [website](#) for directions.

Q. *What are the hours of the centers?*

A. We are open from 10:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. at both locations.

Q. *Do your recyclers charge fees for recycling?*

A. Yes, some do. There are fees for some electronics, paint, and paper shredding. Please visit our [website](#) for details.

Q. *What is the box size the “first box free” paper for shredding?*

A. A cardboard box (think bank box) about 15 – 20 inches long or a kitchen trash bag.

Q. *Will you pay me for any recyclables I bring in (e.g. aluminum cans)?*

A. No, we do not pay for any recyclables.

Q. *Do you take Household Hazardous Waste at your recycling centers?*

A. No we don't.

Q. *Can I volunteer at the centers?*

Q. *Can I bring my school class to tour the recycling facilities?*
