LATEX PAINT*

Atlanta Paint Disposal is Atlanta's premier paint recycling company. APD re-blends collected paint into a new, reusable form, and donates paint to Keep Atlanta Beautiful, Inc. (KAtIB) for graffiti paint overs by numerous city departments.



PAPER SHREDDING*

Global Document Shredding (GDS) is a member of the National Association for Information Destruction. All documents are shredded at the GDS site and will be 100% recycled.

DART Container Corporation promotes sustainability by reprocessing collected foam (excludes packing peanuts) from the public through KAtlB and other community partners.
