

## **Community Recycling Centers**

**Frequently Asked Questions** 

- Q. When are your recycling centers open?
- A. We have two locations; each is open one Saturday each month.
- Q. Where are the locations?
- A. Our Buckhead center, open the first Saturday of each month, is located at 2715 Peachtree Road, in the lower parking lot of the Second-Ponce de Leon Baptist Church. On the second Saturday of each month, our Kirkwood/Edgewood center is held at Coan Middle School at 1550 Hosea L Williams Dr. NE. Visit our website for maps for each location.
- Q. What are the hours of the centers?
- A. We are open from 10:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. at both locations.
- Q. Do your recyclers charge fees for recycling?
- A. Yes, some do. There are fees for some electronics, paint, and paper shredding. Please visit our website for details.
- Q. Will you pay me for any recyclables I bring in (e.g. aluminum cans)?
- A. No, we do not pay for any recyclables.
- Q. Do you take Household Hazardous Waste at your recycling centers?
- A. No we don't.
- Q. Can I volunteer at the centers?

- Q. Can I bring my school class to tour the recycling facilities?
