



Community Recycling Frequently Asked Questions

Q. When is your recycling event?

A. Our community recycling event is held the first Saturday of each month.

Q. Where is the location?

A. Our Buckhead center, open the first Saturday of each month, is located at 2715 Peachtree Road, in the lower parking lot of the Second-Ponce de Leon Baptist Church.

Q. What are the hours of the monthly event?

A. We are open from 10:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m.

Q. Do your recyclers charge fees for recycling?

A. Yes, some do. There are fees for some electronics, paint, and paper shredding. Please visit our website (keepatlantabeautiful.org/recycle) for details.

Q. Will you pay me for any recyclables I bring in (e.g. aluminum cans)?

A. No, we do not pay for any recyclables.

Q. Do you take Household Hazardous Waste at your recycling centers?

A. No we don't.
