ELECTRONICS*

Ecyclers USA collects electronics which are processed, reused or broken down at the Ecyclers USA warehouse in Knoxville, TN. Any remaining e-scrap is passed to R-2 certified partners for responsible recycling.

METALS

Ecyclers USA accepts metals such as steel, aluminum, cans, copper, brass, stainless steel, and appliances such as washers/dryers/stoves/refrigerators. Metals are picked up at the Ecyclers warehouse by PSC Metals and recycled.

GLASS

Ecyclers USA collects clean, food-grade glass containers, jars, and bottles brought to our Community Recycling events and takes them to Strategic Materials for recycling or reuse.



PAPER SHREDDING*

Global Document Shredding (GDS) is a member of the National Association for Information Destruction. All documents are shredded at the GDS site and will be 100% recycled.



LATEX PAINT*

Atlanta Paint Disposal is Atlanta's premier paint recycling company. APD re-blends collected paint into a new, reusable form, and donates paint to Keep Atlanta Beautiful, Inc. (KAtIB) for graffiti paint overs by numerous city departments.



STYROFOAM

DART Container Corporation promotes sustainability by reprocessing collected foam (excludes packing peanuts) from the public through KAtIB and other community partners.



TEXTILES

USAgain is a green enterprise that works to reduce the textile waste going into landfills by making clothes and shoes recycling convenient.



BOOKS

Used books collected by Recycling Management Resources are transported to its plant to be shredded and used to make brown paper products, news material, etc.
