New E-scrap Recycling Vendor

In August, Ecyclers USA joined our list of recycling vendors. Ecyclers USA collects e-waste at our monthly recycling event. Electronics are processed, reused or broken down at the Ecyclers USA warehouse in Knoxville, TN. From there, its R-2 certified partner collects and recycles any leftover e-waste. Ecyclers USA also collects metals and glass* recyclables from our patrons and delivers them to the appropriate facilities.

*Glass is delivered to <mark>Strategic Materials</mark> for processing for use in a wide array of products. Metals are picked up at the Ecyclers warehouse by PSC Metals and recycled.
